

Fleetwood Scholarship



He eventually became Vice President of IT at AIG Insurance in New York, VP of IT at Cigna Insurance in Philadelphia, and worked as an executive consultant at Donegal Mutual Insurance near Harrisburg Pa for many years. He was the founder and CEO of NJRX, an IT consulting firm. For several years, he funded a computer scholarship in Harrisburg, Pa.

Rex was known for his generosity and sense of humor. Even as he traveled around the world for business and pleasure, he never forgot his roots in Kansas and Halstead.
